Purpose:

- To expose and engage scholars to different readers and expand upon their text experience.

Directions:

1. Ask Ms. Lin if being TB tested and live scanned.
2. Choose a time on doodle schedule.
3. Do not tell your scholar – this will help with keeping YOU a mystery to the class!
4. On the Friday before your scheduled time, send Ms. Lin 5 clues about who you are. Scholars will have the opportunity to guess who the mystery reader is throughout the week.
5. Pick a book that is within the scope of first grade interests: colorful, pictures, text that is fun to read (repetition, decodable).
6. Once you've picked a book, prepare three guiding questions to be asked during or after the story. This is for engagement and checking for comprehension.
